A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Civil Actions – Active Duty Service Members – Electronic Deposition and**
3 **Testimony**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a party to a civil action who is entitled to protections under
5 the Service Members Civil Relief Act due to the party's active duty military status
6 to petition the court to be deposed or to testify under penalty of perjury by certain
7 electronic means; requiring a tribunal of the State to cooperate with other tribunals
8 or the appropriate military representative in designating an appropriate location for
9 deposition or testimony offered under this Act; providing for the application of this
10 Act; authorizing the Court of Appeals to adopt certain rules; and generally relating
11 to the electronic deposition and testimony of active duty service members.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

20 **6–412.**

21 **(A) REGARDLESS OF STATE OF RESIDENCY, A PARTY TO A CIVIL ACTION IN**
22 **THIS STATE WHO IS ENTITLED TO PROTECTION UNDER THE FEDERAL SERVICE**
23 **MEMBERS CIVIL RELIEF ACT BECAUSE OF THE PARTY'S ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 STATUS MAY PETITION THE COURT TO BE DEPOSED OR TO TESTIFY UNDER PENALTY
2 OF PERJURY BY TELEPHONE, AUDIOVISUAL MEANS, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC MEANS
3 AT A DESIGNATED TRIBUNAL OR OTHER LOCATION.

4 (B) A TRIBUNAL OF THIS STATE SHALL COOPERATE WITH OTHER
5 TRIBUNALS OR THE APPROPRIATE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES
6 ARMED FORCES IN DESIGNATING AN APPROPRIATE LOCATION FOR THE DEPOSITION
7 OR TESTIMONY.

8 (C) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO ABROGATE OR
9 LIMIT THE PROTECTIONS AND RIGHTS OF A PARTY UNDER THE FEDERAL SERVICE
10 MEMBERS CIVIL RELIEF ACT.

11 (D) THE COURT OF APPEALS MAY ADOPT RULES TO IMPLEMENT THIS
12 SECTION.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2018.
