21	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
22	INDICATED.
23	(2) "Exam fee" means the fee that an individual is required



- 1 TO PAY TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION THAT LEADS TO A PROFESSIONAL LICENSE OR
- 2 CERTIFICATION, INCLUDING AN EXAMINATION REQUIRED TO BE A LICENSED SOCIAL
- 3 WORKER, ATTORNEY, ACCOUNTANT, OR MEDICAL DOCTOR IN THE STATE.
- 4 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE PROFESSIONAL LICENSE OR 5 CERTIFICATION EXAM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.
- 6 (B) (1) THERE IS A SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM KNOWN AS THE 7 PROFESSIONAL LICENSE OR CERTIFICATION EXAM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.
- 8 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO ASSIST INDIVIDUALS WHO 9 PROVIDE A PUBLIC SERVICE TO THE STATE TO PAY FOR AN EXAM FEE.
- 10 (3) THE OFFICE SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.
- 11 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THE 12 PROGRAM IF:
- 13 (1) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS EARNED A GRADUATE, PROFESSIONAL, OR
- 14 DOCTORAL DEGREE FROM AN INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION IN THE
- 15 **STATE**;
- 16 (2) THE INDIVIDUAL SIGNS A LETTER OF INTENT TO BE EMPLOYED IN
 17 THE STATE IN A PUBLIC SERVICE CAPACITY FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR;
- 18 (3) IN THE PRIOR YEAR, THE INDIVIDUAL HAD A FEDERAL ADJUSTED
- 19 GROSS INCOME OF NOT MORE THAN \$39,000 FOR AN INDIVIDUAL OR \$78,000 FOR A
- 20 MARRIED COUPLE FILING A JOINT INCOME TAX RETURN;
- 21 (4) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS NOT RECEIVED A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THE
- 22 PROGRAM IN A PRIOR YEAR; AND
- 23 (5) THE INDIVIDUAL'S EMPLOYER DOES NOT REIMBURSE THE
- 24 INDIVIDUAL FOR THE EXAM FEE.
- 25 (D) THE SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDED TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE 26 PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED THE LESSER OF THE EXAM FEE OR \$500.
- 27 (E) THE OFFICE SHALL ADOPT GUIDELINES OR REGULATIONS NECESSARY 28 TO IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
