A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Civil Penalty for Failure to Pay Video Toll – Limitation**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a certain civil penalty for a video toll violation; making a
4 stylistic change; and generally relating to civil penalties for toll violations.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
6 Article – Transportation

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – Transportation**

13 21–1414.

14 (c) (1) Failure of the person alleged to be liable to pay the video toll under a
15 notice of toll due by the date stated on the notice shall constitute a toll violation subject to
16 a civil citation and a civil penalty **NOT EXCEEDING \$25**, which shall be assessed 15 days
17 after the toll violation occurs, as provided for in the regulations of the Authority.

18 (2) A registered owner of a motor vehicle [shall] **MAY** not be liable for a
19 civil penalty imposed under this section if the operator of the motor vehicle has been
20 convicted of failure or refusal to pay a toll under § 21–1413 of this subtitle for the same
21 violation.
