A BILL ENTITLED
AN ACT concerning
Election Law - Simultaneous Candidacy for Party and Public Office
FOR the purpose of repealing the circumstance under which an individual is not authorized to simultaneously be a candidate for a party office and a public office; and generally relating to simultaneous candidacy for more than one office.
BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Election Law Section 5–204 Annotated Code of Maryland (2017 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article – Election Law
5–204.
(a) An individual simultaneously may not be a candidate for more than one public office.
(b) An individual simultaneously may not be a candidate for more than one office of a political party.
(c) [Unless otherwise prohibited by rule of the applicable political party, an] AN individual simultaneously may be a candidate for a party office and a public office.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
