- 17 UNDER THE COMMON LAW THAT IS NOT RELATED TO A DIVORCE PROCEEDING OR AN
- 18 ADOPTION PROCEEDING UNDER THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.
- 19 (B) IN CONSIDERING A PETITION FOR A CHANGE OF NAME, THE COURT
- 20 SHALL GIVE SPECIAL CONSIDERATION AS POTENTIAL EVIDENCE OF FRAUDULENT
- 21 INTENT TO AN OBJECTION TO THE PETITION CLAIMING THAT THE PETITIONER IS
- 22 SEEKING TO ADOPT:
 - (1) THE NAME OF THE INDIVIDUAL FILING THE OBJECTION; OR

- 1 (2) THE NAME OF A RELATIVE OF THE INDIVIDUAL FILING THE 2 OBJECTION WHO HAS DIED WITHIN 1 YEAR BEFORE THE FILING OF THE PETITION.
