## A BILL ENTITLED

# Vehicle Laws - Personal Motor Vehicle Rentals

3 FOR the purpose of establishing provisions of law governing the rental of personal motor 4 vehicles to other persons in a certain manner; establishing that certain persons may  $\mathbf{5}$ rent only certain classes of personal motor vehicles to other persons; prohibiting a 6 renter of a personal motor vehicle from using the motor vehicle for certain purposes; 7 prohibiting a certain person from renting a personal motor vehicle to another person 8 unless certain requirements are met; prohibiting a certain person from renting a 9 personal motor vehicle to another person if the personal motor vehicle is subject to a manufacturer's recall; prohibiting a certain person from renting a personal motor 1011 vehicle to another person who does not meet certain driver's licensing standards; 12requiring a certain person that rents or facilitates the rental of a personal motor 13 vehicle to keep certain records; authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration or any 14police officer to inspect certain records; providing for the application of certain 15provisions of law governing for-rent vehicles and personal motor vehicle rentals; 16establishing that certain violations of this Act are unfair or deceptive trade practices 17subject to certain enforcement actions; requiring that motor vehicles used in a 18 personal motor vehicle rental program be subject to certain annual safety 19inspections; defining certain terms; and generally relating to personal motor vehicle 20rentals.

$23 \\ 24 \\ 25 \\ 26$	(B) "PERSONAL MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL" MEANS THE PAID USE OF A PERSONAL PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE BY A PERSON OTHER THAN THE REGISTERED OWNER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE THROUGH THE USE OF A PERSONAL MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL PROGRAM.

(C) "PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM OR PROCESS, WHETHER DIGITAL,

7 (A) THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES TO A PERSONAL MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL FOR 8 A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 180 DAYS.

9 (B) (1) AN OWNER OR A PROVIDER MAY RENT TO ANOTHER PERSON ONLY 10 A PERSONAL CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE, A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE, OR A 11 CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE THROUGH THE USE OF A PROGRAM.

12 (2) A RENTER OF A PERSONAL CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE OR 13 CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE MAY NOT USE THE RENTED PERSONAL MOTOR 14 VEHICLE TO TRANSPORT INDIVIDUALS OR PROPERTY FOR HIRE.

18(1)THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS SECURED IN THE SAME FORM WITH THE19SAME MINIMUM BENEFITS AS REQUIRED UNDER TITLE 17 OF THIS ARTICLE;

20 (2) THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS INSPECTED AND CERTIFIED ANNUALLY 21 BY A MECHANIC REGISTERED UNDER § 23–103.1 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

22 (3) WHEN USING AIRPORT PROPERTY TO FACILITATE A PERSONAL 23 MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL, THE OWNER OR PROVIDER DOES SO UNDER AN 24 AGREEMENT WITH THE MARYLAND AVIATION COMMISSION.

4 (a) (1) Before the Administration titles and registers any used vehicle, except 5 a Class L (historic) vehicle, it shall require the applicant to present a valid inspection 6 certificate for the vehicle.

7 (2) For the purposes of this subsection, an inspection certificate shall 8 remain valid from the date the inspection certificate is issued for a period of:

9 (i) 90 days; or

10 (ii) In the case of an inspection certificate issued for a used vehicle 11 owned and held in inventory by a dealer licensed under Title 15 of this article, the earlier 12 of:

13 1. 6 months; or

14 2. When 1,000 miles have been added to the vehicle's 15 odometer since the inspection certificate was issued.

16 (3) This subsection does not apply to any vehicle transferred within 30 days 17 after the date of an inspection certificate issued for the vehicle and filed by the 18 Administration in its title records.

19 (b) (1) If a person applies for titling and registration of a vehicle, the 20 Administration may:

(i) Withhold delivery of a certificate of title pending receipt of aninspection certificate; and

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(ii) Issue a temporary registration.

24 (2) A vehicle for which a temporary registration has been issued under this 25 subsection shall be inspected within 60 days of the issuance of the temporary registration.

26 (c) (1) When an existing school vehicle (Class H) is changed to any other 27 registration class, the vehicle shall be inspected at a licensed State inspection station.

(2) The inspection certificate shall be submitted at the time the vehicle is
being registered in the new class.

30 (d) All buses other than those that are required to be inspected annually by the
 31 Public Service Commission or by the Administration shall be inspected annually at a
 32 licensed State inspection station.

1 (E) ALL MOTOR VEHICLES USED IN A PERSONAL MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL 2 PROGRAM UNDER TITLE 18, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE INSPECTED 3 ANNUALLY AT A LICENSED STATE INSPECTION STATION.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2018.
