4 (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Board may not 5 issue a new license for an establishment that is within 300 feet in a direct line of a place of 6 worship or a public or nonpublic kindergarten, elementary, or secondary school.

7 (2) The distance from the establishment to the place of worship or the 8 public or nonpublic kindergarten, elementary, or secondary school is to be measured from 9 the establishment in a direct line to the nearest point of the main building of the place of 10 worship or school.

11 (b) The prohibition against issuing a license in subsection (a) of this section does 12 not apply to the issuance of:

13 (1) a license for a premises that was licensed on October 1, 1996;

14 (2) a Class B (on-sale) beer, wine, and liquor license for a premises in 15 Cambridge [or], Secretary, OR HURLOCK; or

16 (3) a temporary license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2018.
