A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration – Parking Placards – Color Photograph**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a parking placard issued to a person with a disability
4 include on its face a certain color photograph of the person to whom the parking
5 placard is issued; and generally relating to disability parking placards.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Transportation**

14 13–616.1.

15 (e) (1) A parking placard for a person with a disability shall [be]:

16 (I) **BE** issued:

17 [(i)] **1.** Except as provided in item [(ii)] **2** or [item (iii)] **3** of this
18 [paragraph] **ITEM**, in the form of a removable windshield placard capable of being hung
19 from the inside rearview mirror and of a size and design as determined by the
20 Administration;

21 [(ii)] **2.** For a vehicle not equipped with an inside rearview mirror

1 or in which the inside rearview mirror is not visible from the rear of the vehicle, in the form
2 of a windshield placard of a size and design as determined by the Administration; or

3 **[(iii)] 3.** For a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle, in the form of a sticker
4 of a size and design as designated by the Administration; **AND**

5 **(ii) INCLUDE ON ITS FACE A COLOR PHOTOGRAPH OF THE**
6 **PERSON TO WHOM THE PARKING PLACARD IS ISSUED THAT IS TAKEN IN**
7 **ACCORDANCE WITH PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2018.
