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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration and Local Health Departments – Birth and Death**  
3 **Certificates – Issuance of Copies**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to access electronically  
5 from the Maryland Department of Health a copy of a birth certificate or death  
6 certificate; authorizing a local health department to access electronically from the  
7 Department a copy of a death certificate; authorizing the Administration to provide  
8 a copy of a birth certificate or death certificate to a certain person under certain  
9 circumstances; authorizing a local health department to provide a copy of a death  
10 certificate to a certain person under certain circumstances; authorizing the  
11 Administration to set and collect a fee for processing and issuing a birth certificate  
12 or death certificate or for a certain report; establishing requirements for certain fees  
13 collected by the Administration; providing for the distribution of certain fees  
14 collected by the Administration; correcting an erroneous reference to a federal law;  
15 and generally relating to the issuance of copies of birth certificates and death  
16 certificates.

17 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 **Article – Health – General**

25 4-217.

(i) Access electronically from the Department a certified or abridged copy of a birth certificate **OR DEATH CERTIFICATE** registered under this subtitle; and

(3) (i) The Secretary shall provide on request, to any person authorized by regulation adopted under this subtitle, a commemorative birth certificate.

14 (ii) The Department shall set a fee for the commemorative birth  
15 certificate.

16 (iii) The commemorative birth certificate shall:

21 (iv) A portion of the funds collected under this paragraph shall go to  
22 the Department for the production costs of issuing the commemorative birth certificates.  
23 The remainder of the funds collected shall be paid into the Children's Trust Fund  
24 established under § 13–2207 of this article to provide funding for the Child Abuse Medical  
25 Providers (Maryland CHAMP) Initiative.

26 (v) The Secretary shall adopt regulations to implement the  
27 provisions of this paragraph.

28 (c) (1) Except as otherwise provided by law:

29 (i) The Department shall collect a \$12 fee:

32 2. For a report that a search of the fetal death, marriage, or

1 divorce verification certificate files was made and the requested record is not on file;

2                   3. For each change to a fetal death, marriage, or divorce  
3 verification certificate made later than one year after the certificate has been registered  
4 with the Department; or

5                   4. To process an adoption, foreign adoption, or legitimization;

6                   (ii) The Department shall collect a \$10 fee:

7                   1. Except as provided in paragraph (6)(ii) of this subsection,  
8 for each certified or abridged copy of a birth certificate;

9                   2. For the first copy of a certified or abridged death certificate  
10 issued in a single transaction;

11                  3. For a report that a search of the birth or death certificate  
12 files was made and the requested record is not on file; or

13                  4. For each change to a birth or death certificate made later  
14 than 1 year after the certificate has been registered with the Department; and

15                  (iii) The Department shall collect a \$12 fee for each additional  
16 certified or abridged copy of a death certificate provided concurrently with an initial  
17 requested death certificate.

18                  (2) From the fee the Department collects under paragraph (1) of this  
19 subsection, the Department shall transfer the entire fee to the General Fund.

20                  (3) (i) Any local health department **OR THE MOTOR VEHICLE**  
21 **ADMINISTRATION** may set and collect a fee for processing and issuing a birth certificate,  
22 or for a report that a search of the files was made and the requested record is not on file,  
23 that covers:

24                   1. The administrative costs of providing this service; and

25                   2. The requirements of subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph.

26                  (ii) The fee set by the local health department **OR THE MOTOR**  
27 **VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION** for processing and issuing a birth certificate or for a report  
28 under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph may not exceed the actual costs to the local health  
29 department **OR THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION** for processing and issuing a  
30 birth certificate or a report.

31                  (iii) From the fee the local health department **OR THE MOTOR**  
32 **VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION** collects under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, \$10 shall

1 be transferred to the General Fund.

2 (iv) Prior to setting and collecting a fee for processing and issuing a  
3 birth certificate or for a report under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, the local health  
4 department **OR THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION** shall enter into a  
5 memorandum of understanding with the Maryland Department of Health that outlines the  
6 local health department's **OR THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION'S** fee structure.

7 (4) The Department [or], a local health department, **OR THE MOTOR**  
8 **VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION** may collect a fee for a certificate requested by an agency of  
9 the State or any of its political subdivisions.

10 (5) The Secretary may waive all or part of a fee if chargeable to an agency  
11 of the United States.

12 (6) (i) The Department may not collect a fee for a copy of a vital record  
13 issued to:

14 1. A current or former member of the armed forces of the  
15 United States; or

16 2. The surviving spouse or child of the member, if the copy  
17 will be used in connection with a claim for a dependent or beneficiary of the member.

18 (ii) 1. In this subparagraph, "homeless individual" has the  
19 meaning stated in the federal McKinney–Vento Homeless **EDUCATION** Assistance  
20 **IMPROVEMENTS Act OF 2001** (42 U.S.C. § 11302(a)).

21 2. Subject to sub subparagraph 4 of this subparagraph, the  
22 Department may not collect a fee for a certified or an abridged copy of a birth certificate  
23 issued to a homeless individual.

24 3. The Department shall accept as proof of homelessness a  
25 signed written statement from a homeless services provider located in the State that:

26 A. Affirms that the individual is homeless; and

27 B. Includes the address to which the copy of the birth  
28 certificate requested under this section may be sent.

29 4. A homeless individual may receive one copy of a birth  
30 certificate without a fee in a single transaction.

31 5. The Department shall adopt regulations to implement this  
32 subparagraph.

1                   (d) (1) Any local health department **OR THE MOTOR VEHICLE**  
2 **ADMINISTRATION** may set and collect a fee for processing and issuing a death certificate  
3 that covers the administrative costs of providing this service.

4                   (2) The fee set by the local health department **OR THE MOTOR VEHICLE**  
5 **ADMINISTRATION** for processing and issuing a death certificate under this subsection may  
6 not exceed the actual costs to the local health department **OR THE MOTOR VEHICLE**  
7 **ADMINISTRATION** for processing and issuing a death certificate.

8                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 2018.
