- 5 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND THE REGISTRATION OF A SCHOOL BUS THAT IS NOT INSPECTED, REPAIRED, OR MAINTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2018.
