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- (d) Before December 15, 2016, the Commission may not require an applicant for a permanent transportation network operator's license to comply with subsection (c) of this section if a transportation network company for which the applicant will provide services, at the time it applies for a permit, provides to the Commission details of the process the transportation network company uses to collect, review, and submit the information specified in subsection (b)(2) of this section. (e) (1) A transportation network company may request that the Commission waive the requirement to comply with subsection (c) of this section and instead require compliance with subsection (b)(2) of this section for applicants and operators of the transportation network company. On receipt of a request under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the Commission shall: (i) determine whether the transportation network company's process for complying with subsection (b)(2) of this section can be shown to be as comprehensive and accurate as complying with the supplemental criminal background check as set forth under § 10–104(b) of this title; and (ii) within 3 months after receiving the request, determine whether to: 1. grant the waiver; 2. deny the waiver; or 3. approve an alternative process.
