## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Higher Education – Cybersecurity Public Service Scholarship Program

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Cybersecurity Public Service Scholarship Program; 4 specifying the purpose of the Program; requiring the Office of Student Financial  $\mathbf{5}$ Assistance in the Maryland Higher Education Commission to administer the 6 Program; specifying certain eligibility requirements for an applicant to the Program; 7 authorizing a certain scholarship award to be used at any eligible institution to pay 8 for certain education expenses; requiring a scholarship recipient to maintain a 9 certain grade point average; specifying a certain amount of time a recipient may hold a certain scholarship; requiring a scholarship recipient to work for a unit of State 10 11 government in the cybersecurity field or teach in a public high school in the State in 12a certain education program for a certain amount of time; requiring a scholarship 13 recipient to repay the Commission certain funds under certain circumstances; 14 authorizing the Office to waive repayment of certain funds under certain circumstances; requiring funds for the Program to be as provided in the annual 1516 budget by the Governor; requiring the Office to adopt certain regulations; defining 17certain terms; and generally relating to the Cybersecurity Public Service Scholarship 18 Program.

### 1 SUBTITLE 34. CYBERSECURITY PUBLIC SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

2 **18–3401.** 

3 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 4 INDICATED.

5 (B) "ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION" MEANS A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE NONPROFIT 6 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE THAT POSSESSES A 7 CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL FROM THE COMMISSION.

8 (C) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE CYBERSECURITY PUBLIC SERVICE 9 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

10 **18–3402.** 

11 (A) THERE IS A SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM KNOWN AS THE CYBERSECURITY 12 PUBLIC SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IN THE STATE.

13 **(B)** THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO SUPPORT STUDENTS WHO ARE 14 PURSUING AN EDUCATION IN PROGRAMS THAT ARE DIRECTLY RELEVANT TO 15 CYBERSECURITY.

16 **18–3403.** 

17 (A) THE OFFICE SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.

18 **(B)** AN INDIVIDUAL MAY APPLY TO THE OFFICE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER 19 THIS SUBTITLE IF THE INDIVIDUAL:

- 20
- (1) IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE;

(2) IS A JUNIOR, SENIOR, OR GRADUATE STUDENT WHO IS ENROLLED
 FULL-TIME AT AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION IN AN ACCREDITED DEGREE PROGRAM
 THAT IS DIRECTLY RELEVANT TO CYBERSECURITY;

24 (3) IS WITHIN 2 YEARS OF GRADUATION FROM THE INDIVIDUAL'S 25 DEGREE PROGRAM;

26 (4) HAS MAINTAINED A CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF AT 27 LEAST 3.0 ON A 4.0 SCALE; AND

28 (5) HAS NOT RECEIVED, AND HAS NO PLANS TO RECEIVE, A FEDERAL

1 CYBERCORPS SCHOLARSHIP FOR SERVICE.

2 (C) A SCHOLARSHIP AWARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE USED AT ANY 3 ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION TO PAY FOR EDUCATION EXPENSES AS DEFINED BY THE 4 OFFICE, INCLUDING:

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(1) TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES; AND

6 (2) ROOM AND BOARD.

7 (D) A SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT SHALL MAINTAIN A GRADE POINT AVERAGE 8 OF AT LEAST 3.0 ON A 4.0 SCALE.

9 (E) EACH RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY HOLD 10 THE AWARD FOR 2 YEARS OF FULL-TIME STUDY.

11 **18–3404.** 

12 (A) FOR 1 YEAR FOR EACH YEAR THAT THE RECIPIENT RECEIVES A 13 SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, A SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT SHALL:

14 (1) WORK FOR A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT IN THE 15 CYBERSECURITY FIELD; OR

16 (2) TEACH IN A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE STATE IN AN 17 EDUCATION PROGRAM THAT IS DIRECTLY RELEVANT TO CYBERSECURITY.

18 **(B)** IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 18–112 OF THIS TITLE, A SCHOLARSHIP 19 RECIPIENT SHALL REPAY THE COMMISSION THE FUNDS RECEIVED UNDER THIS 20 SUBTITLE IF THE RECIPIENT DOES NOT:

21 (1) EARN CREDIT AS A FULL-TIME STUDENT AS DEFINED IN 22 REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE OFFICE FOR THE PROGRAM;

23(2)COMPLETE AN ACCREDITED DEGREE PROGRAM THAT IS24DIRECTLY RELEVANT TO CYBERSECURITY AT AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION; AND

25 (3) PERFORM THE WORK OBLIGATION REQUIRED UNDER 26 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

27 (C) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A RECIPIENT 28 SHALL BEGIN REPAYMENT AT ANY TIME DURING THE PERIOD THAT THE RECIPIENT 29 IS NO LONGER PERFORMING THE WORK OBLIGATION REQUIRED UNDER 1 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

2 (D) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, REPAYMENT 3 SHALL BE MADE TO THE STATE WITHIN 6 YEARS AFTER THE REPAYMENT PERIOD 4 BEGINS AND SHALL FOLLOW A REPAYMENT SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED BY THE 5 OFFICE.

6 (E) THE OFFICE MAY WAIVE OR DEFER REPAYMENT IN THE EVENT OF 7 DISABILITY OR EXTENDED SICKNESS THAT PREVENTS THE RECIPIENT FROM 8 FULFILLING THE WORK OBLIGATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS 9 SECTION.

10 **18–3405.** 

11 FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET 12 OF THE COMMISSION BY THE GOVERNOR.

13 **18–3406.** 

14 (A) THE OFFICE SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 15 SUBTITLE.

16 **(B)** THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 17 SHALL:

18 (1) IDENTIFY THE PROGRAMS THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 19 18–3403(B)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

20(2)DEFINE THE NUMBER OF CREDITS A SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT21MUST EARN AS A FULL-TIME STUDENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 1, 2018.

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
