- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Education
- 17 4–133.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a county board shall award **HIGH**SCHOOL credit to a middle school student for any course [for]:
- 20 **(1) FOR** which a high school student would be awarded credit if the middle school student meets the same requirements as the high school student; **OR**
- 22 (2) THAT THE DEPARTMENT HAS APPROVED FOR THE AWARD OF 23 HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT UNDER § 7–1002 OF THIS ARTICLE.



SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
