State Government – Notaries Public – Travel Fees

FOR the purpose of authorizing a notary public to charge a reasonable fee, rather than certain fees established in statute or by regulation of the Secretary of State, as compensation for travel required for the performance of a notarial act; requiring the notary public, before incurring the travel expense, to inform the person requesting the notarial act of the travel fee that will be charged; requiring the notary public to provide a receipt separately itemizing the travel fee to the person who paid for the notarial act; and generally relating to travel fees for notaries public.

(a) The Secretary of State shall adopt regulations to establish fees, not to exceed
\$4 for an original notarial act, and an appropriate lesser amount for the repetition of that
original notarial act or to make a copy of the matter addressed by that original notarial act.

(b) (1) A notary public may charge [19 cents per mile, or a higher amount set by regulation of the Secretary of State, and a fee not to exceed \$5,] A REASONABLE FEE as compensation for travel required for the performance of a notarial act.

1 (2) FOR ANY FEE CHARGED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 2 SUBSECTION, A NOTARY PUBLIC SHALL:

3(I)BEFORE INCURRING THE TRAVEL EXPENSE, INFORM THE4PERSON REQUESTING THE NOTARIAL ACT OF THE FEE THAT WILL BE CHARGED; AND

5(II)PROVIDE THE PERSON WHO PAID FOR THE NOTARIAL ACT A6RECEIPT SEPARATELY ITEMIZING THE TRAVEL FEE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2018.
