BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Transportation Section 13-402(a)(1) and (c)(12)Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Transportation Section 21–104.2 Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Transportation** 13-402.

- Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the 1 (1)(a) 2 Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on 3 a highway shall be registered under this subtitle. 4 Registration under this subtitle is not required for: (c) 5 A golf cart that is operated on a highway in the City of Crisfield, (12)6 Somerset County, in accordance with § 21–104.2 of this article; 7 21-104.2.8 A person who operates a golf cart on a highway in the City of Crisfield, (a) 9 Somerset County, without registration as authorized under § 13–402(c)(12) of this article: May operate the golf cart only: 10 (1) 11 (i) On a highway: 12 1. That is not designated or maintained as a part or an extension of the [State or] federal highway system; and 13 14 2. On which the maximum posted speed limit does not exceed 35 miles per hour; 15 16 (ii) Between dawn and dusk; and If the golf cart is equipped with lighting devices as required by 17 (iii) 18 the Administration; 19 (2)Shall keep the golf cart as far to the right of the roadway as feasible; 20and 21(3) Shall possess a valid driver's license. 22 The State Highway Administration, in consultation with the City of Crisfield, 23may designate a location in the City of Crisfield where a person operating a golf cart may 24cross, at a right angle, a highway that is designated or maintained as a part or an extension 25of the [State or] federal highway system.
