4 FOR the purpose of modifying the deadline by which a license holder annually must present
5 to the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City a certain certificate
6 regarding certain personal property taxes; and generally relating to the Board of
7 License Commissioners for Baltimore City.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 (a) The Board shall immediately suspend without a hearing the renewal license
5 of a license holder that fails to present to the Board by ~~[June]~~ **OCTOBER** 30 annually a
6 certificate issued by the Director of Finance showing that all personal property taxes due
7 to the City or State are paid.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
9 1, 2018.
