- 21 (a) The State Superintendent shall require each county superintendent to hold a 22 fire drill in each public school in accordance with the State Fire Prevention Code

13	(II) PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS;
14 15	(2) meet the requirements of the current National Fire Protection Association standards; and
16 17	(3) be approved by the State Fire Marshal or the local authority with jurisdiction over the enforcement of fire codes.
18 19	(b) (1) In a jurisdiction in which building permits are issued, a sprinkler system shall be installed in:
20 21 22	(i) each newly constructed dormitory, hotel, lodging or rooming house, or multifamily residential dwelling for which the initial building permit is issued on or after July 1, 1990; [and]
23 24	(ii) each newly constructed town house for which the initial building permit is issued on or after July 1, 1992; AND
25	(III) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDING.
26 27	(2) In a jurisdiction in which building permits are not issued, a sprinkler system shall be installed in:
28 29	(i) each dormitory, hotel, lodging or rooming house, or multifamily residential dwelling on which construction begins on or after July 1, 1990; [and]

1 2	(ii) each town house on which construction begins on or after July 1, 1992; AND
3	(III) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDING.
