8 (B) THE TRUST IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(2) OR (3)(III) OF 9 THIS SECTION TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR DISAPPROVE OR APPROVE AND 10 SUPERVISE, THE COORDINATION, SECURITY, AND SCHEDULING OF RALLIES AND 11 OTHER EVENTS HELD ON LAWYER'S MALL.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2018.
