

15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
17	Article - State Personnel and Pensions
18	25–401.
19	(a) A member may retire with a normal service retirement allowance if:
20	(1) on or before the date of retirement, the member:
21	(i) has at least 20 years of eligibility service;
22 23	(ii) 1. is a correctional case management specialist, supervisor, or manager on or before June 30, 2016;

- 6 (b) On retirement under this section, a member is entitled to receive a normal service retirement allowance that equals one fifty—fifth of the member's average final compensation multiplied by the number of years of creditable service.
 - (c) (1) This subsection applies only to:

- 10 (i) a correctional case management specialist, supervisor, or 11 manager who has a combined total of 20 years of eligibility service as provided in subsection 12 (a)(1)(ii) of this section; [or]
- 13 (ii) a member serving in a position specified in § 25–201(a)(8) or (9) 14 of this title who has a combined total of 20 years of eligibility service as provided in subsection (a)(1)(iii) of this section; **OR**
- (III) A MEMBER SERVING IN A POSITION SPECIFIED IN § 17 25–201(A)(1) OF THIS TITLE WHO HAS A COMBINED TOTAL OF 20 YEARS OF ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A)(1)(V) OF THIS SECTION.
- 19 (2) A member is entitled to receive a normal service retirement allowance 20 that equals an allowance based on the creditable service the member has in the 21 Correctional Officers' Retirement System.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before October 1, 2018, the State Retirement Agency shall notify the individuals who are affected by this Act of their right to apply service credit from the Employees' Retirement System of the City of Baltimore to the Correctional Officers' Retirement System.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
