BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 7–123 Annotated Code of Maryland (2014 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 7-123.There is a Robotics Grant Program in the State. (a) (1) The purpose of the Program is to provide grants to public schools and nonprofit robotics clubs in the State to support existing robotics programs and to increase the number of robotics programs in the State.
