## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County – Board of Education – Compensation**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the amount of compensation of the president and other voting  
4 members of the Carroll County Board of Education; providing that this Act does not  
5 apply to the compensation of the president or other voting members of the county  
6 board during a certain term of office; and generally relating to the Carroll County  
7 Board of Education.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – Education  
10 Section 3–403(a)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2014 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 3–403.

17 (a) The president of the county board is entitled to receive [~~\$7,500~~] **\$9,000**  
18 annually as compensation and the other voting members are entitled to receive [~~\$6,500~~]  
19 **\$8,000** each annually as compensation.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35  
21 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the  
22 compensation of the president and other voting members of the Carroll County Board of  
23 Education while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act,  
24 but the provisions of this Act concerning the compensation of the president and other voting

1 members of the Carroll County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the  
2 next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or  
3 elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
5 1, 2018.
