A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 HBCU Internship in Maryland Government Scholarship Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the HBCU Internship in Maryland Government 4 Scholarship Program; establishing the purpose of the Program; requiring the Office $\mathbf{5}$ of Student Financial Assistance in the Maryland Higher Education Commission to 6 administer the Program, subject to a certain exception; requiring the Office to set 7 dates on or before which applications must be submitted; authorizing an HBCU to 8 nominate eligible students to participate in the Program; establishing the HBCU 9 Internship in Maryland Government Scholarship Committee; providing for the 10 composition and staffing of the Committee; prohibiting a member of the Committee 11 from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain 12expenses; requiring the Committee to select a certain number of students each year 13 from each HBCU who have agreed to serve in government internships to participate 14 in the Program; requiring the Committee to select certain replacement students if certain other students decline to participate in the Program; requiring that priority 1516for selection to participate in the Program be given to certain students; providing for 17the Committee's selection and quorum requirements; requiring the Office to provide 18 scholarships on or before certain dates each year; requiring that the recipient of a 19scholarship receive a certain amount; requiring the Office to adopt certain 20regulations; authorizing the Office to adopt certain regulations; requiring the 21Governor to include a certain appropriation in the annual budget bill for certain 22fiscal years to administer the Program; defining certain terms; and generally 23relating to the HBCU Internship in Maryland Government Scholarship Program.

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1 BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2020 AND IN EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, 2 THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL A GENERAL FUND 3 APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF AT LEAST \$150,000 TO ADMINISTER THE 4 PROGRAM.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2018.
