## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Gaming – Fantasy Competitions – Prohibition on Operation of Electronic Device**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from operating a certain kiosk or machine that  
4 offers fantasy competition to the public; and generally relating to the regulation of  
5 fantasy competition.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Criminal Law

15 (a) In this section, “fantasy competition” includes any online fantasy or simulated  
16 game or contest such as fantasy sports, in which:

17 (1) participants own, manage, or coach imaginary teams;

18 (2) all prizes and awards offered to winning participants are established  
19 and made known to participants in advance of the game or contest;

20 (3) the winning outcome of the game or contest reflects the relative skill of  
21 the participants and is determined by statistics generated by actual individuals (players or  
22 teams in the case of a professional sport); and

- 1           (4) no winning outcome is based:
- 2                   (i) solely on the performance of an individual athlete; or
- 3                   (ii) on the score, point spread, or any performances of any single
- 4 real-world team or any combination of real-world teams.
- 5           (b) **(1)** Notwithstanding the provisions of this or any other title, **AND EXCEPT**
- 6 **AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION**, the prohibitions against
- 7 betting, wagering, and gambling do not apply to participation in a fantasy competition.
- 8                   **(2) A PERSON IN THE STATE MAY NOT OPERATE A KIOSK OR MACHINE**
- 9 **PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN A PLACE OF BUSINESS THAT OFFERS FANTASY**
- 10 **COMPETITION TO THE PUBLIC.**
- 11           (c) The Comptroller may adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this
- 12 section.

13           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

14 October 1, 2018.
