24	(a) (2) As to all or any part of any transportation facilities project, the

Authority may:

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- 1 (i) Fix, revise, charge, and collect rentals, rates, fees, tolls, and other 2 charges and revenues for its use or for its services; and
- 3 (ii) Contract with any person who desires its use for any purpose and 4 fix the terms, conditions, rentals, rates, fees, tolls, or other charges or revenues for this use.
- 5 (c) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the rentals, rates, fees, tolls, and other charges and revenues are not subject to supervision or regulation by any instrumentality, agency, or unit of this State or any of its political subdivisions.
- 8 (2) This subtitle does not permit the exercise of any power or the 9 undertaking of any activity that would conflict with the provisions and limitations of the 10 federal Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964.
- 11 (3) Tolls for the use of the bridge carrying the John F. Kennedy Memorial 12 Highway over the Susquehanna River may not be less than the comparable tolls charged 13 for the use of the Susquehanna River Bridge.
- 14 (4) (I) IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "JERSEY BARRIER" MEANS A WALL OR 15 PARTITION THAT SEPARATES LANES OF TRAFFIC.
- 16 (II) THE AUTHORITY SHALL ALLOW A VEHICLE TO BYPASS THE 17 BROENING HIGHWAY/AUTHORITY DRIVE TOLL FACILITY IF THE VEHICLE:
- 18 **1.** ENTERS THE OUTER LOOP OF INTERSTATE **695** FROM BROENING HIGHWAY/AUTHORITY DRIVE; AND
- 20 **2. DOES NOT TRAVERSE THE FRANCIS SCOTT KEY** 21 **BRIDGE.**
- (III) THE AUTHORITY MAY SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF
  SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH BY CONSTRUCTING AND MAINTAINING A
  JERSEY BARRIER THAT SEPARATES THE TRAFFIC ENTERING THE BROENING
  HIGHWAY/AUTHORITY DRIVE TOLL FACILITY FROM THE TRAFFIC BYPASSING THE
  FACILITY.
- (5) Prior to fixing or revising tolls on any part of any transportation facilities project, the Authority shall provide, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee, Senate Finance Committee, House Appropriations Committee, and House Ways and Means Committee information on the proposed toll charges, including:
  - (i) The annual revenues generated by the toll charges;

- 1 (ii) The proposed use of the revenues; and
- 2 (iii) The proposed commuter discount rates.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4  $\,$  1, 2018.
