17 (H) (1) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019, AND AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 6 YEARS 18 THEREAFTER, THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS SHALL CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF 19 THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT TO EVALUATE THE EFFECTIVENESS 20 AND EFFICIENCY OF THE FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT PRACTICES OF THE BALTIMORE 21 CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

(2) THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS SHALL PROVIDE
 INFORMATION REGARDING THE AUDIT PROCESS TO THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE
 DEPARTMENT BEFORE THE AUDIT IS CONDUCTED.
