## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## Task Force to Standardize Data Collection on Race and Ethnicity

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Standardize Data Collection on Race 4 and Ethnicity; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; 5 prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but 6 authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to 7 study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task 8 Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General 9 Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Standardize Data Collection on Race and 10 11 Ethnicity.
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That:

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- 14 (a) There is a Task Force to Standardize Data Collection on Race and Ethnicity.
- 15 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 16 (1) a member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the
- 17 Senate;
- 18 (2) a member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the
- 19 House;
- 20 (3) the Attorney General, or the Attorney General's designee;
- 21 (4) the Public Defender, or the Public Defender's designee;
- 22 (5) a representative of the Governor's Office of Crime Control and
- 23 Prevention;

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 2018. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of
- 4 June 30, 2019, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be
- 5 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
