## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## Baltimore County – Alcoholic Beverages – Education Conference Facility/Dining Service License

4 FOR the purpose of establishing in Baltimore County a Class B-ECF/DS beer, wine, and  $\mathbf{5}$ liquor license; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore County 6 to issue the license to certain people; authorizing the license holder to sell beer, wine, 7 and liquor for on-premises consumption at certain University of Maryland, 8 Baltimore County events; requiring profits from beer, wine, and liquor sales to be 9 deposited into a certain account; authorizing the Board to regulate the manner in 10 which beer, wine, and liquor is dispensed under the license; requiring the Board to 11 perform certain functions before issuing the license; requiring certain policies of the 12University to be included in an application for the license; establishing certain hours 13 and days of sale for the license; establishing a certain annual license fee; and 14 generally relating to a Class B–ECF/DS beer, wine, and liquor license.

**(E)** (1) (2) (3) SHALL REQUIRE THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, BALTIMORE (4) COUNTY TO REPORT TO THE BOARD AT LEAST 5 DAYS BEFORE UNIVERSITY-AUTHORIZED EVENT AT WHICH BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR IS INTENDED TO BE SOLD OR SERVED.

 $\mathbf{5}$ BEFORE ISSUING THE LICENSE, SHALL DESIGNATE THE EXACT 6 CAMPUS LOCATIONS FOR THE OUTLETS FOR THE SALE OF BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR;

7 SHALL MAINTAIN A MAP AND DESCRIPTION OF THE DESIGNATED 8 OUTLETS FOR VERIFICATION ON THE RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE; AND
