1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County – Terms**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the terms of the members of the Housing Commission of Anne
4 Arundel County; providing for the termination of the terms of certain members of
5 the Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County; and generally relating to the
6 Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article – Housing and Community Development
9 Section 14–103
10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (2006 Volume and 2017 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Housing and Community Development**

15 14–103.

16 (a) The Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County consists of seven
17 Commissioners, appointed by the County Executive.

18 (b) The term of a Commissioner is **[5] 4 years COTERMINOUS WITH THAT OF**

1 **THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE.**

2 (c) [The terms of the Commissioners are staggered as required by the terms
3 provided for Commissioners of the Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County on
4 October 1, 2006.

5 (d) A Commissioner who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the
6 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the members
8 serving on the Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County on the effective date of this
9 Act shall expire at the end of December 1, 2018.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2018.
