The grantee organization is The Fund for Art in Ellicott City, Inc., a 501(c)(3) entity dedicated to furthering the creation and installation of public art in historic Ellicott City.					

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The arts community in Old Ellicott City is small and has low public visibility. New, public art in the form of large scale murals could jump start the nascent arts community, assist the economic development of the area, and attract visitors to the uniquely historic Patapsco River Valley. This public arts project supports the Patapsco Valley Heritage Area, which the State has designated to preserve, protect, interpret and restore the environment, history and culture of the Patapsco River Valley. One mural would be on the side of the old Ellicott Theatre, and the other on the side of the original Ford dealership, which sold Fords from the Model T to the late 1950 models.
