The City of Seat Pleasant is an incorporated municipality in Prince George's County .The City provides public works, police, code enforcement, public engagement and general government support to residents and business located in the city.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The City of Seat Pleasant has undertaking a project to refit it's City Hall and Public Works Facilities with Smart City technology and information systems that will allow the city to provide faster, better, and more personalized services to its residents in the city, county, and state. To finance this project, the city is using 4.1 million of its own funds for the construction and modernization of these facilities. During the renovation and modernizing period, the City Hall and Public Work staff will be required to move to a temporary location referred to as a swing space for approximately one year. The city do not have a temporary structure to accommodate the staff during the construction. Therefore the city will be require to procure temporary trailers. These temporary trailers will be modified to accommodate the City Hall and Public Work staff. The estimated cost is \$500,000. The city is requesting state funding of \$500,000 for the swing space.
