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**Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Compact – Department of Planning – Name Correction**

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This bill makes technical corrections related to the name of the Maryland Department of Planning in the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) Compact. The bill also repeals related and obsolete contingency language. **The bill takes effect June 1, 2018.**

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**Analysis**

**Bill Summary/Current Law:** WMATA was established in 1967 through an interstate compact among Maryland, Virginia, and the District of Columbia. The compact currently references the Maryland *Office* of Planning; however, the office became a principal department of State government and was renamed as the Maryland *Department* of Planning pursuant to Chapter 209 of 2000.
