28. Comments
The building, a former summer kitchen converted to an artist's studio and gallery, is on property slated for development which precludes renovating or moving it on site. Lucy School is an ideal location because the school employs an arts-based curriculum and plans to use the studio as a studio, gathering spot and gallery for its students and faculty. The building fits into the historical context of the site and will be available for public inspection and enjoyment on selected occasions. The site provides for needed parking and security.
