The Alice Ferguson Foundation (AFF) serves thousands of Maryland students each year at its environmental education campus located on a 330 acre working farm on the shores of the Potomac River. Through single day and overnight experiences AFF connects people to the natural world, sustainable agriculture practices, and the cultural heritage of their local watershed through education, demonstration, and stewardship. AFF enhances classroom curriculum for students by highlighting scientific, agricultural and ecological principles mapped to Next Generation Science Standards. Pre-K through 12th grade students explore the watershed, learn about food production, and investigate sustainability concepts. AFF also provides professional development opportunities for teachers to enhance their teaching skills. More information can be found at www.fergusonfoundation.org.

Alice Ferguson Foundation's Potomac Watershed Study Center includes a day use education
building, an overnight lodge, two overnight cabins, a wetland boardwalk and a living
shoreline along the Potomac River. The remaining piece of this project is the construction of a
new lodge. The current overnight lodge, constructed in 1974, has a recurring mold and can no
longer be used. Completing this project is critical to continuing to provide outdoor education
programs to 4,000 students each year. This public-private partnership supports the local

economy through employment and models the latest green construction practices.
