10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

Cape St. Claire Improvement Association, Inc, (the CSCIA) is tasked with managing more than 30 acres of property. This includes three beaches & parks, boat ramp and launching marina, two other piers, Lake Claire, its surrounding streams and woods, along with a few other small parks and maintains the ownership of the Cape St. Claire Shopping Center and its commercial common areas. The CSCIA also administers the Special Community Benefit District for the Cape St Claire Community.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Cape St. Claire has two areas we would like to tackle in our project: The Main Beach and the Beach at Lake Claire. The Main Beach has experienced significant erosion since the loss of the jetties from Isabel in 2003 and Lake Claire continues to suffer from eroding shorelines that threatens both the local ecological system, community property and a neighboring marina. We have engaged the services of Biohabitats to plan our project and have scheduled a premeeting with the various permitting agencies on February 22, 2018. We have already invested nearly \$80,000 in this effort, with an estimate of \$1.8 million more needed to complete the project. The plans call for significant capital investment in jetties and groins to mitigate sand movement and reduce wave energy, along with restoration of living shore lines. Our plans would call for hard structured, capital improvements that would last in excess of 15 years.
