Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County - Terms

This bill reduces the terms of members of the Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County from five years to four years, coterminous with that of the county executive. The terms of the members currently serving on the commission terminate December 1, 2018.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill applies only to Anne Arundel County.

Local Effect: The bill does not materially affect Anne Arundel County's finances or operations.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law/Background: The Housing Commission of Anne Arundel County consists of seven commissioners appointed by the county executive. Commissioners serve staggered five-year terms. A commissioner appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

The commission is a local public agency that provides safe, decent, and quality affordable housing and supportive services to eligible persons with limited incomes through a variety of federal, State, local, and private resources.
