10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

Gandhi Brigade Youth Media offers after-school programs that train middle and high school students in digital media skills, encouraging them to become engaged in issues that are important to them. Our programs teach young people how to craft effective media messages while helping them understand complex civic issues. They learn to find their voice and are empowered to initiative change in their communities. Our youth have created a wide range of media projects: from award winning documentaries on Maryland's juvenile justice system, immigration and police accountability to public service announcements on cyber-bullying, drunk driving and the benefits of diversity. Gandhi Brigade participants are at the forefront of digital multimedia advocacy. At the same time, they are learning important and marketable skills.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

For our entire 10-year history, Gandhi Brigade has operated in churches, libraries and storefronts. Not having a permanent home has made it difficult for us to fully realize the full potential of our innovative digital programs. With a 20-year lease in hand, we now have a chance to expand both our programs and our scope of service in a new home at the Silver Spring Library. Having a permanent space gives us the exciting opportunity to rethink and expand the organization's programming. We envision growing from 200 students at 12 countywide sites to serving more than 400 youth a month in our new center as well as offsite locations. And that doesn't include special events and gatherings, like our annual Montgomery County Youth Media Festival. Our new programming priorities will include: expansion of programs for teenage girls, web design and video gaming development, GED and reentry programs and workshops for seniors.
