Our House is a job training program that provides workforce development through our job training program (carpentry,culinary skills,small engine repair,basic computer skills) during						

training program (carpentry,culinary skills,small engine repair,basic computer skills) during the day and academics/life skills in the evenings. Our immediate goal is to get our trainees "off the streets" into a highly structured and intensely supervised home situation that is nurturing and drug/alcohol/violence free. Long term they have the opportunity to earn a Maryland High School diploma, attain the skills to secure a satisfactory and meaningful job in the building trades, organic farming, culinary field and become tax-paying members of their communities. NOTE RE: The matching fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act, INCLUDING FUNDS EXPENDED ON OR AFTER JANUARY1.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The newly completed dormitory is built to house up to 24 adolescent males, ages 16-21, referred by the Departments of Social Services and Juvenile Services. The new dorm provides individual rooms for each trainees (in the current dormitory two trainees share a room), lavatories, lounge/recreation room, meeting room, staff office, sick room and laundry facilities. The old dormitory will be renovated to become classrooms and counseling rooms as well as larger dining hall. NOTE RE: The matching fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act, INCLUDING FUNDS EXPENDED ON OR AFTER JANUARY1.
