Baltimore City - Chief Executive Officer of the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners - Title Change

This bill changes the title of the Chief Executive Officer of the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners. Under the bill, the Chief Executive Officer is instead called the Superintendent. The publisher of the Annotated Code, in consultation with the Department of Legislative Services, is required to change cross references and terminology throughout the code and to describe each change in an editor's note. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2018.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The bill does not materially affect Baltimore City finances or operations.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law/Background: Chapter 105 of 1997 restructured the management of the Baltimore City Public School System contingent on the State providing additional funding to the city. As part of the restructuring process, the title for the school superintendent was changed to the Chief Executive Officer. In Maryland, Baltimore City and Prince George's County are the only two local school systems that use the title Chief Executive Officer for their school superintendent.
