<b>10. Description and Purpose of Organization</b> (Limit length to visible area)							

Associated Catholic Charities, Inc., was founded in 1923 to serve immigrant orphans, and our mission states: "Inspired by the Gospel mandates to love, serve, and teach, Catholic Charities provides care and services to improve the lives of Marylanders in need." Catholic Charities is the leading nonprofit human services agency in Maryland and has provided services to children and families, the elderly, the disadvantaged, and people with developmental disabilities for more than 90 years. We operates 80 human services programs through three service divisions: Senior Services, Community Services and Family Services. Collectively, these programs touched the lives of 160,000 children, families, and adults in FY2017. One of the most vulnerable populations Catholic Charities serves include fragile older adults with low incomes.

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

Located on the Jenkins Senior Living Campus, St. Joachim and DePaul Houses consist of 199 rent-assisted one- and two-bedroom apartments for seniors capable of living independently or with minimal supportive services. DePaul was built from new construction in 1983. St. Joachim House was opened in the early 1990s in what was previously the Jenkins Memorial Nursing Home and before that the Jenkins Memorial Hospital which opened in 1926. While the buildings have been well maintained, their age is showing. The seniors have difficulty opening and closing their windows. They also allow hot air to escape and drafts to come in. One of the compressors in the chiller at Joachim has a freon leak, putting additional stress on the compressor that is operational. Water damage from a leak in the roof has become apparent to the residents. The proposed project would replace the windows in both buildings as well as the chiller and roof at Joachim.

25D: For each unit we receive rent and a subsidy from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. For St. Joachim House, the average rent is \$322 per month and the average subsidy \$456. For DePaul House, the average rent is \$265 per month and the average subsidy \$867. The 199 units are 560 sq feet each.

27: Joachim was built in 1926 but was completely rehabbed and converted to apartments in 1995
