AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 852
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Zucker” and substitute “Zucker, and Simonaire”; in line 4, after the first “of” insert “altering the definition of “military spouse” to include the surviving spouse of a service member who dies at any time before an application for a license; altering the definition of “veteran” to include former service members who have been discharged for more than 1 year before an application for a license;”; in the same line, after “requiring” insert “units of”; strike beginning with “establish” in line 5 down through “Department;” in line 8 and substitute “issue a certain license to certain applicants within a certain period of time; repealing references to the issuance of a temporary license to certain applicants;”; in line 11, strike “approve or disapprove an application for” and substitute “issue”; in the same line, strike “a temporary” and substitute “an”; after line 13, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

Article - Business Regulation

Section 2.5-101(a)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2015 Replacement Volume and 2018 Supplement)”;

in line 16, after “Section” insert “2.5–101(c) and (f).”; and in the same line, after “2.5–105” insert a comma.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 21, insert:

“2.5–101.

(Over)

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- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (c) (1) “Military spouse” means the spouse of a service member or veteran.
- (2) “Military spouse” includes a surviving spouse of:
- (i) a veteran; or
- (ii) a service member who died [within 1 year] before the date on which the application for a license is submitted.
- (f) [(1)] “Veteran” means a former service member who was discharged from active duty under circumstances other than dishonorable [within 1 year] before the date on which the application for a license is submitted.

[(2) “Veteran” does not include an individual who has completed active duty and has been discharged for more than 1 year before the application for a license is submitted.]”;

and in line 23, strike “temporary”.

On page 2, strike beginning with “**THE**” in line 1 down through “**PERIOD**” in line 4 and substitute “**IF A SERVICE MEMBER, VETERAN, OR MILITARY SPOUSE MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE, A UNIT SHALL ISSUE THE LICENSE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING A COMPLETED APPLICATION**”; strike in their entirety lines 5 through 8, inclusive; in line 9, strike “(c)” and substitute “**(B)**”; in lines 9 and 24, in each instance, strike “temporary”; in line 24, strike “(d)” and substitute “**(C)**”; in line 29, strike “**TEMPORARY**”; and strike beginning with “**AND**” in line 29 down through “**LICENSE**” in line 30.

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On page 3, in line 2, strike “**APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE AN APPLICATION FOR**” and substitute “**ISSUE**”; in the same line, strike “**TEMPORARY**”; in line 3, strike “**ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT**”; in line 5, strike “**TEMPORARY**”; in line 8, strike “temporary”; in line 9, strike the brackets; strike line 10 in its entirety; in line 11, strike “**(3)**” and substitute “**(2)**”; in line 12, strike “**APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE AN APPLICATION FOR**” and substitute “**ISSUE**”; in the same line, strike “**TEMPORARY**”; and in line 13, strike “**ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT**”.
