## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and West" and substitute "<u>West, Benson,</u> <u>Ellis, Guzzone, Kagan, Lam, Nathan–Pulliam, and Patterson</u>"; and in line 4, after the semicolon insert "<u>providing that this Act may not be interpreted to disrupt certain</u> <u>programs</u>;".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 22, strike "LAND" and substitute "<u>, AS DETERMINED BY DATA</u> <u>USED IN THE MOST CURRENT CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED MODEL DEFINED</u> <u>IN COMAR 26.08.11.03</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 28, after the comma insert "<u>That this Act may not be</u> interpreted to expand, limit, or otherwise disrupt any program conducted by a unit of State or local government in accordance with to the Chesapeake Bay Total Maximum Daily Load, a municipal separate storm sewer system permit, urban tree canopy goals, or any other local program.
