AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 605

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Kelly” and substitute “Delegates Kelly, Pendergrass, Pena–Melnyk, Bagnall, Barron, Carr, Charles, Chisholm, Cullison, Hill, Johnson, Kerr, Kipke, Krebs, R. Lewis, Metzgar, Morgan, Rosenberg, Saab, Sample–Hughes, Szeliga, and K. Young”; in line 3, after “Practitioners” insert “and Psychiatrists”; in line 12, after “purpose;” insert “altering the date on which a certain provision of law regarding psychiatrists and telemedicine terminates;”; in line 13, after “date;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act;”; and after line 19, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 691 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2018  
Section 3”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 15, insert:

“Chapter 691 of the Acts of 2018

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018. It shall remain effective for a period of [2] 3 years and, at the end of September 30, [2020] 2021, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”;

and in line 24, after “2019.” insert “It shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 3 of Chapter 691 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2018. If that termination provision takes effect, this Act, with no further
