AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 285, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, in line 17, after “regulations;” insert “requiring the Department of the Environment to study the environmental impacts of alternatives to expanded polystyrene food service products and submit its findings to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the application of certain provisions of this Act;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4 of the bill, in lines 6 and 8, in each instance, strike “**ON**” and substitute “**EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, ON**”; and after line 10, insert:

“(C) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A FOOD SERVICE BUSINESS OR SCHOOL THAT IS LOCATED IN A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY THAT IMPLEMENTS A PROGRAM TO RECYCLE EXPANDED POLYSTYRENE WITHIN THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY.”

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0285/614637/1), in line 2 of Amendment No. 4, strike “**(C)**” and substitute “**(D)**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5 of the bill, after line 18, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before December 1, 2019, the Department of the Environment shall study the environmental impacts of

alternatives to expanded polystyrene food service products and submit its findings to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.”;

and line 19, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
