AMENDMENT NO. 1

Strike in their entirety the House Judiciary Committee Amendments (HB1165/942217/1).

On page 1 of the bill, strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute:

"<u>State and Local Correctional Facilities – Undocumented Immigrants – Transfer to</u> <u>United States Department of Homeland Security</u> (Keep Our Communities Safe Act of 2019)";

strike beginning with "prohibiting" in line 4 down through "agents" in line 11 and substitute "<u>requiring a State or local correctional facility with custody of a certain undocumented immigrant to transfer the individual to the United States Department of Homeland Security under certain circumstances; and generally relating to <u>undocumented immigrants and State and local correctional facilities</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 12 through 17, inclusive, and substitute:</u>

<u>Article – Correctional Services</u> <u>Section 9–617</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2017 Replacement Volume and 2018 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 1 through line 8 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:
