AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 166, AS AMENDED

<u>AMENDMENT NO. 1</u>

On page 1 of the Economic Matters Committee Amendments (HB0166/243596/1), in line 7, strike "<u>, subject to a certain exception and a certain limitation</u>"; in line 11, strike "<u>, subject to a certain limitation</u>"; and strike beginning with "<u>requiring</u>" in line 13 down through "<u>time</u>" in line 14 and substitute "<u>providing that certain minimum wage</u> rate increases are postponed under certain circumstances for a certain period of time".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 14 of the Economic Matters Committee Amendments, in line 17 of Amendment No. 4, strike "(1)"; strike beginning with "<u>SUBJECT</u>" in line 17 down through "<u>ON</u>" in line 18 and substitute "<u>ON</u>"; and in line 19, strike "<u>OCTOBER 1, 2024</u>" and substitute "<u>THE STATE MINIMUM WAGE RATE EQUALS \$15.00 PER HOUR</u>".

On page 15 of the Economic Matters Committee Amendments, in Amendment No. 4, strike in their entirety lines 3 through 6, inclusive; in line 7, strike "<u>SUBJECT TO</u> <u>SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE</u>" and substitute "<u>THE</u>"; in line 10, strike "<u>(B)(1)</u>" and substitute "<u>(B)</u>"; strike in their entirety lines 18 through 20, inclusive; and in line 21, strike "<u>(E)</u>" and substitute "<u>(D)</u>".

On page 16 of the Economic Matters Committee Amendments, in Amendment No. 4, strike in their entirety lines 4 through 6, inclusive, and substitute:

"(2) <u>ALL SUBSEQUENT MINIMUM WAGE RATE INCREASES</u> <u>SPECIFIED IN § 3–413(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE POSTPONED BY AN</u> <u>ADDITIONAL YEAR;</u>".
