AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1007 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, strike ", to the greatest extent practicable,"; in line 15, strike "authorizing" and substitute "<u>requiring</u>"; strike beginning with "beginning" in line 16 down through "year" in line 17; and in line 21, after "prosecutions;" insert "<u>making clarifying and technical changes</u>;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "TO" in line 15 down through the comma in line 16; in lines 26 and 27, strike "§ 3–602" and substitute "<u>TITLE 3, SUBTITLE 6</u>"; in lines 27 and 30, in each instance, after "ARTICLE" insert "<u>AND TITLE 5, SUBTITLE 7 OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE</u>"; and in line 29, strike "§§ 3–601 AND 3–602.1" and substitute "<u>TITLE 3, SUBTITLE 6</u>".

On page 3, in line 9, after "ORGANIZATION" insert "<u>THAT IS</u>"; and in line 10, after "CODE" insert "<u>AND REPRESENTS URBAN, RURAL, AND SUBURBAN CHILD</u> <u>ADVOCACY CENTERS IN THE STATE</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 6 through 31, inclusive, and substitute:

"(E) (1) MONEY FOR CHILD ADVOCACY CENTERS:

(I) SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO CHILD ADVOCACY CENTERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A FORMULA AGREED ON BY THE MARYLAND STATEWIDE

(Over)

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ORGANIZATION FOR CHILD ADVOCACY CENTERS AND THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION;

(II) SHALL BE USED TO SUPPLEMENT, NOT SUPPLANT, MONEY THAT THE PROGRAM RECEIVES FROM OTHER SOURCES; AND

(III) MAY BE USED TO ASSIST CHILD ADVOCACY CENTERS IN MEETING THE STANDARDS UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) <u>THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPROPRIATE AT LEAST \$300,000 IN</u> <u>THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL FOR THE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTERS UNDER THIS</u> SECTION.".

On page 5, in line 18, strike "October" and substitute "July".
