AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "Solicitation" insert "<u>and Conspiracy</u>"; in the same line, strike "– Penalty" and substitute "<u>Resulting in Death</u>"; after line 2, insert:

"(Stacey's Law)";

strike beginning with "repealing" in line 3 down through "Act;" in line 6 and substitute "<u>clarifying that a person who solicits another or conspires with another to commit</u> <u>murder in the first degree is guilty of murder in the first degree if the death of another</u> <u>occurs as a result of the solicitation or conspiracy</u>;"; in line 7, after "solicitation" insert "<u>and conspiracy</u>"; strike in their entirety lines 9 through 13, inclusive; and in line 15, strike "2–211" and substitute "<u>2–201</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 1 through line 14 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

(b) (1) <u>A person who commits a murder in the first degree is guilty of a</u> felony and on conviction shall be sentenced to:

- (i) imprisonment for life without the possibility of parole; or
- (ii) imprisonment for life.

(2) Unless a sentence of imprisonment for life without the possibility of parole is imposed in compliance with § 2–203 of this subtitle and § 2–304 of this title, the sentence shall be imprisonment for life.

(C) A PERSON WHO SOLICITS ANOTHER OR CONSPIRES WITH ANOTHER TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE IS GUILTY OF MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE IF THE DEATH OF ANOTHER OCCURS AS A RESULT OF THE SOLICITATION OR CONSPIRACY.".

On page 2, in line 15, strike "3." and substitute "<u>2.</u>".
