AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 5, strike "(1)"; strike in their entirety lines 7 through 9, inclusive, and substitute:

"(C) (1) <u>A LICENSE HOLDER MAY INSTALL A PROTECTIVE COVERING</u> OVER AN EXTERIOR DOOR OR WINDOW OF THE LICENSED PREMISES IF THE <u>COVERING IS:</u>

(I) USED ONLY WHEN THE LICENSED PREMISES IS NOT

OCCUPIED;

(II) <u>DESIGNED TO PROTECT THE LICENSED PREMISES FROM</u> UNLAWFUL INTRUSION OR DESTRUCTION; AND

(III) <u>SECURED ONLY FROM THE EXTERIOR OF THE LICENSED</u> PREMISES.

(2) <u>THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PREVENT AN INSPECTION AND</u> SEARCH OF THE LICENSED PREMISES UNDER § 6–202 OF THIS ARTICLE.";
