Baltimore City - Weapons on School Property - School Resource Officer

AN ACT concerning 2

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 17
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article - Criminal Law
- 20 4-102.
- 21 (a) This section does not apply to:
- 22 (1) a law enforcement officer in the regular course of the officer's duty;

1 an off-duty law enforcement officer or a person who has retired as a law (2)2 enforcement officer in good standing from a law enforcement agency of the United States, 3 the State, or a local unit in the State who is a parent, guardian, or visitor of a student attending a school located on the public school property, provided that: 4 5 (i) the officer or retired officer is displaying the officer's or retired 6 officer's badge or credential; 7 the weapon carried or possessed by the officer or retired officer is (ii) 8 concealed; and 9 (iii) the officer or retired officer is authorized to carry a concealed 10 handgun in the State; 11 a person hired by a county board of education specifically for the (3)purpose of guarding public school property; 12 13 (4) a person engaged in organized shooting activity for educational 14 purposes; [or] 15 (5)a person who, with a written invitation from the school principal, 16 displays or engages in a historical demonstration using a weapon or a replica of a weapon for educational purposes; OR 17 18 **(6)** A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER, AS DEFINED IN § 7–1501 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, WHO IS ASSIGNED TO A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN BALTIMORE CITY 19 AND IS ON PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY IN BALTIMORE CITY. 20 21A person may not carry or possess a firearm, knife, or deadly weapon of any 22 kind on public school property. 23Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a person who (c) violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment 2425not exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both. 26 A person who is convicted of carrying or possessing a handgun in 27 violation of this section shall be sentenced under Subtitle 2 of this title. 28 Article - Education 29 7-1501.

In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

31 (j) "School resource officer" means:

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(a)

- 1 (1) A law enforcement officer as defined under § 3–101(e) of the Public Safety Article who has been assigned to a school in accordance with a memorandum of understanding between the chief of a law enforcement agency as defined under § 3–101(b) of the Public Safety Article and the local education agency; or
- 5 (2) A Baltimore City school police officer, as defined in  $\S$  4–318 of this 6 article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  $8\,\,$  1, 2019.
