SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 13Article Election Law
- 14 10-301.1.
- 15 (d) Each early voting center shall be open for voting as follows:

16 (1) beginning the second Thursday before a primary or general election 17 through the Thursday before the election; and

18 (2) during the following hours:

1 (i) in a [presidential] general election, during the hours between 8 2 a.m. and 8 p.m. each early voting day; and

3 (ii) in [all other elections] A PRIMARY ELECTION, during the hours 4 between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. each early voting day.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2019.
